Hungary has great roles over the world in peacekeeping operations since end of 19<sup>th</sup> Century. It has peacekeeping operations during it was member of Austro-Hungarian armed forces, some of them are : 1897 Island of Crete , 1901 Boxer Rebellion in China,1902-1907 Kosova and 1902-1914 in Albania. Also Hungarian soldiers worked under protection of International Inspection and Supervision Comitte during 1973-1975 as peacekeepers in South Vietnam. During 20<sup>th</sup> and 21<sup>st</sup> Centuries Hungary took part in lots of UN ,NATO,EU and other peacekeeping operations and joined to NATO's Partnership of Peace Program in 1994.

Hungary is member of United Nations since 1955 and took part in fallowing operations and still important part of them ; **UNFCYP** (United Nations Peacekeeping Force in Cyprus) This operation still continue for preventing fight between Turkish Cypriot and Greek Cypriot from1964, Hungary started to give support in 1995.**UNMIK**(United Nations Interim Administration Mission In Kosovo) mission established in 1999 and finally **MINURSO**(United Nations Mission for the Referendum in Western Sahara ) was established in 1991 to provide period before referendum in West Sahra. Those operations and operations above which are not related with UN are indicator of Importance which Hungary give to Peacekeeping in world.

Hungary strongly believes that Peacekeeping operations are really important for peace in world and they are getting much more important by the dangerous improvement of War Technologies and Defense Industries. For United Nations It is critical to meet the expectation of population and host country and satisfy the requirements of peacekeeping to manage it UN should obtain more trust, more love and more respect of both sides to have more ottority.
