

BODRUM PRIVATE MARMARA COLLEGE IB WORLD SCHOOL

The International Baccalaureate® (IB) Diploma Programme (DP) curriculum sets out the requirements for study of the DP.

The curriculum is made up of the <u>DP core</u> and <u>six subject groups</u>. Made up of the <u>three required components</u>, the DP core aims to broaden students' educational experience and challenge them to apply their knowledge and skills.

The three core elements are: (Mandatory)

- Theory of knowledge (TOK), in which students reflect on the nature of knowledge and onhow we know what we claim to know.
- The extended essay (EE), which is an independent, self-directed piece of research, finishing with a 4,000-word paper.
- Creativity, activity, service (CAS), in which students complete a project related to those three concepts.

The six subject groups are: (Available in Bodrum Marmara College 2023-2025 IB DP Registrations) (There are different courses within each subject group.)

Candidates have to choose <u>1 subject from each group</u>. There must be <u>3 High Level (HL)</u> and 3 Standard Level (SL) subjects.

1) Studies in language and literature

- English A. Literature (SL/HL)
- Turkish A. Literature (SL/HL)

2) Language acquisition

- English B (SL/HL)
- German B (SL/HL)
- French B (SL/HL)
- German Ab Initio (SL only)
- French Ab Initio (SL only)



3) Individuals and societies

- Turkey in the 20th Century (SL only) (Authorized School Based Subject)
- Our school does not offer the courses listed below but there are Pamoja Online courses (Fees apply – around 1300 USD yearly)
 - Economics (SL/HL)
 - Business Management (SL/HL)
 - Digital Society (SL/HL)
 - Psychology (SL/HL)

4) Sciences

- Biology (SL/HL)
- Chemistry (SL/HL)
- Physics (SL/HL)

5) Mathematics

- Maths: Analysis and Approaches (SL/HL)
- Maths: Applications and Interpretation (SL/HL)

6) The arts

- Visual Arts (SL/HL)
- Pamoja Online Film (SL only) (Fees apply around 1300 USD yearly)

^{**} A candidate who will not choose any Group 6 subject, he/she can choose 2 Science subjects or a new foreign language (French or German Ab Initio) from the start.



Important Notes:

• Students must select at least ONE SUBJECT from <u>each group</u>. The 6th subject may be selected either from the arts subject group or from any other subject groups.

When selecting, there are 2 options:

Option 1) There must be 3 HL and 3 SL

Option 2) There must be 4 HL and 2 SL

To be awarded a diploma,

- The candidate's total points should be at least 24. (The highest score is 45)
- No "N" has been given for TOK and the EE.
- No "E" has been awarded for one or both of TOK and the EE. (There is a matrix for TOK and EE) An E or N is a failing condition and it means no diploma is awarded.
- There shouldn't be a grade 1 awarded in a subject/level.
- If Grade 2 has been awarded three or more times (SL or HL), no diploma is awarded.
- If a grade 3 or below has been awarded four or more times (SL or HL), no diploma is awarded.
- The candidate should gain at least 12 points on HL subjects (For candidates who register for four HL subjects, the three highest grades count).
- The candidate should gain at least 9 points on SL subjects (Candidates who register for two SL subjects, must gain at least 5 points at SL)
